WAZIP provides point-of-sale vouchers for eligible zero-emission commercial vehicles and equipment, so you save money upfront.

What is WAZIP?

The Washington Zero-Emission Incentive Program (WAZIP) is Washington's first statewide voucher incentive program for zero-emission commercial vehicles and equipment.

Whether you operate a single vehicle or manage a larger fleet, WAZIP makes it easier to afford to invest in zero-emission trucks and equipment through point-of-sale incentives.

How can WAZIP help me?

- Discounts at time of the purchase, without waiting for rebates
- Expert support to help you understand incentives, requirements, and next steps
- Long-term savings from reduced fuel and maintenance costs

Zero-emission equipment for you also means a better environment for all of us.

How does it work?

- 1 Connect with WAZIP experts to receive personal guidance as they walk you through eligibility, incentives, and planning.
- 2 Choose an approved dealership that is offering eligible zero-emission vehicles or equipment.
- 3 Work with your chosen Dealer as they apply for your voucher at the time of your purchase.
- 4 Put your vehicle to work by saving on fuel and maintenance costs with zero-emission technology.
- 5 Get ongoing support from WAZIP experts who remain available to help as your needs evolve.
